- maximize their quality of life

- prevent unnecessary or premature institutionalization

INTAKE & REFERRAL (I&R)

The entry point for assessing the needs of elders, families and caregivers:

- makes initial assessment determining what assistance might be needed
- provides information about OCES' services and other community resources that are appropriate

CARE MANAGEMENT

Provides on-going support and coordinates services for elders:

- conducts thorough in-home assessments to identify needs and problem areas
- develops customized plans to link elders with necessary services that may include:
 - homemaker
 - personal care
 - home delivered meals
 - chore
 - supportive day care
 - adult day health
 - respite care
 - emergency shelter
 - habilitation therapy
 - home health aide
 - minor home repair

COORDINATION OF CARE

Staffed with Registered Nurses, OCES' Health Unit:

- evaluates in-home health care needs and other health related issues
- works with the elder, the elder's support network (family, friends, etc.) and the elder's OCES Care Manager to identify and provide the most appropriate service options available
